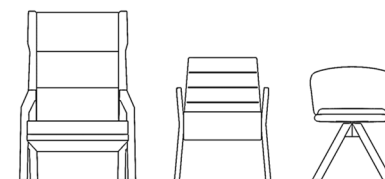

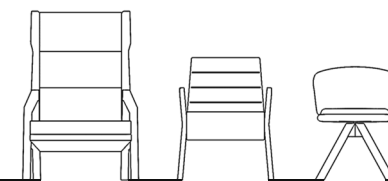

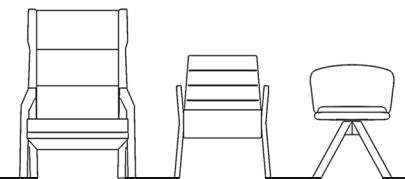
## Introduction

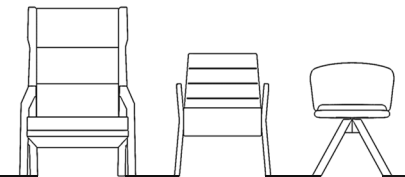
The elegant simplicity, generous proportions and inviting appearance of our **Columba** seating aims to appeal to a wide range of healthcare and care environments.

COLUMK8008	Columba Mid Back Armchair

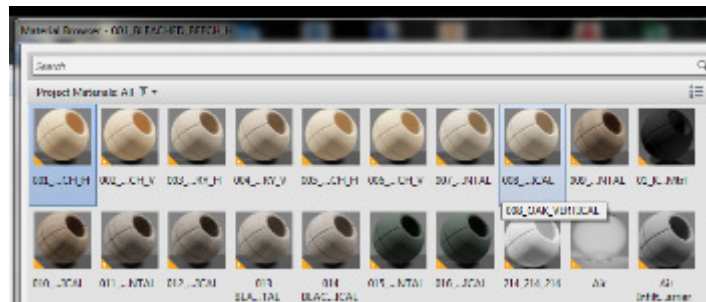


## Loading

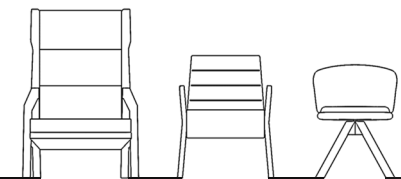
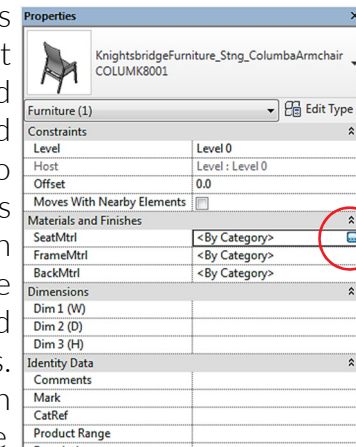
The simplest way to load an object in to your project is to drag it direct from the folder you've saved it in. Alternatively, once you've saved the family in an appropriate location, you can browse to that location via the Load Family panel in the Insert tab.



Once your new family is loaded into your project you can manipulate its materials and finishes. Our standard timber/table top finish are preloaded in the BIM file, so no need to set these up, but we've also included the Jpegs in the zip file.



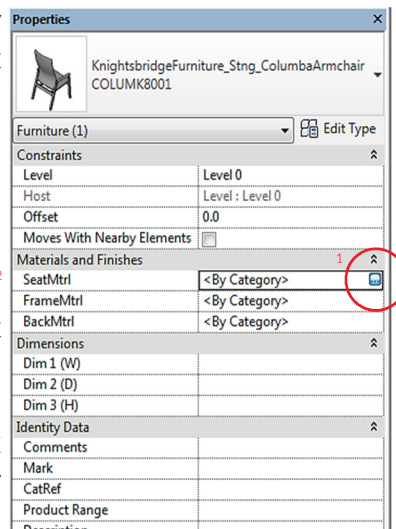
To access the materials and finishes panel just select your already loaded object (it'll turn blue) and click the radial button to open the Materials browser. Here you can assign one of our preloaded standard timber/table top materials. For fabrics, we offer an extensive range in a wide choice of colours and patterns from leading UK manufacturers.



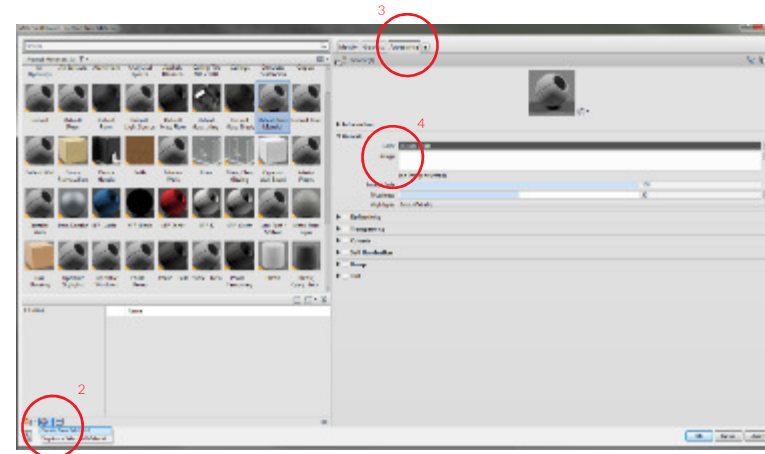
# Materials

## Fabrics

We can offer you a wide choice of fabrics and vinyl's in an extensive range of colours and styles. Our stock fabrics meet BS5852 part 2 crib 5 flame retardancy, but because we offer such a considerable choice it's impossible to include all these in the family. However, it's really easy to add them. Simply select your object and in the Properties panel click the radial button<sup>1</sup> to access the Material Browser. Here you can create a new material.<sup>2</sup> Rename your default new material, then in the Appearance<sup>3</sup> tab click in the Image<sup>4</sup> box and brows to your chosen fabric. This

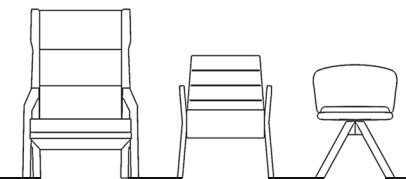


will now be assigned to one of the material parameters and will appear on the BIM component when Graphic Display Option is set to realistic.

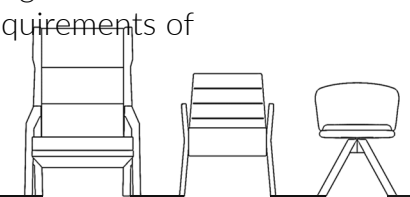
